



Syringe Driver T34

Course Description

The Syringe Driver qualification consists of a mixture of theory and practical application of techniques. Clients are requested to ensure that the training room supplied is suitable for theory delivery (i.e. a TV or suitably clear wall for the projector) and the practical element (enough space to allow the delegates to conduct the practical element with the models in designated areas).

- List the indications of using a syringe driver
- Discuss the legal and professional considerations around syringe driver use
- Review the procedure for setting up a McKinley T34 syringe driver
- Identify the potential sites to use when setting up a syringe driver and where to avoid
- Recognise the medications that can be used within a syringe driver, and the symptoms they can help with
- Relate the medications that can be used to combined symptoms and the compatibility of key medications
- Demonstrate the correct use and set up of a McKinley T34 syringe driver in simulation
